



# 1. Health and Dental Care

If you're married to an active duty service member, you and your children are eligible for healthcare and premium-based dental insurance plans. See www.tricare.mil for more information.

# 2. Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP)

This program assists Sailors who have family members with special medical, dental, mental health, developmental or educational requirements. EFMP representatives can help you navigate available resources such as assistive technology, support groups and other services. # 3. Child Care

The Navy's Child Development Centers (CDC) and after-school programs are among the best in the nation. # To-Do List for New Navy Spouses

- 1. Make sure your Sailor has enrolled you in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS). You will need this to get medical care and other benefits.
- 2. Memorize your Sailor's Social Security number and keep your Sailor's rate, rank, department or division, email, mailing address and full command name on your phone or other handy location. You will need this information for all sorts of paperwork and forms.
- 3. Obtain a military identification card. An ID card will give you access to military exchanges, commissaries and other facilities on base.
- 4. Learn to read and understand your Sailor's Leave and Earnings Statement (LES). See https:// www.dfas.mil/militarymembers/ payentitlements/les.html for more information.
- 5. Find out who your Ombudsman is (or volunteer to become one). Ombudsmen are the spouses of command members who are specially trained to provide assistance and referrals during times of emergency and volunteer to serve as a liaisons between a command's leaders and associated families.
- 6. Ask your Sailor to list you as a beneficiary on his or her Serviceman's Group Life Insurance (SGLI) policy and update his or her record of emergency data sheet (DD Form 93). http://www.benefits. va.gov/insurance/sgli.asp

7. Visit your installation Fleet & Family Support Center (FFSC). There you will find helpful information and referrals for anything else you might need to feel at home at your new duty station. Turn the page to learn more about the many free services offered through FFSC.







**MOVING & RELOCATION** 

The Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) ensures service members will be assigned to a location where the special needs of the family will be met. EFMP is a mandatory program for spouses, children and dependent family members, who require special medical, psychological, or educational services.

The Exceptional Family Member will then be assigned a category according to diagnosis, availability of care and intensity of care. Category 1 is the least complex, while 5 is the most complex; Category 6 is for temporary placement in the EFM program, for example, high-risk pregnancy or a premature infant.

The category assigned to a family member will impact what duty stations a family can accompany their service member, however, enrollment in EFMP does not affect one's career, as promotion boards are unaware of EFM status.

Fleet & Family Support Center can help with the needs of the whole family and the challenges families might face. Visit your FFSC or scan the QR code to learn more.

MWR Outdoor Recreation Centers are your one-stop shop for outdoor activities – from helping plan a trip to renting snowshoes, kayaks, tents, and bikes. They also have backyard party items like horseshoes, barbecue grills and ice chests. Visit with friendly staff and get info on where to go and what to do. They'll make sure you are properly outfitted with gear to make your adventure complete.
